Sandra Shares How English Class Helps Her Everyday Life

Sandra, originally from Puerto Rico, has been taking classes at LVGH since the fall of 2020. She came to us with the simple goal of wanting to understand more English, and in just a few months, she really felt that she'd made an improvement. *"My neighbors speak to me in English and lately, I can understand them more,"* she says. *"I can speak English back to them a little more and a little better."*

In addition to feeling more comfortable and empowered in her neighborhood, Sandra says her strengthened English skills have also been really important in her medical appointments. "I want to be able to speak to my doctor. When we use a translator, sometimes they don't say everything the doctor says-just the main points. Now, I can understand for myself. I can ask questions and learn what I need to know."

As for taking classes during the pandemic, Sandra says it actually made it easier for her to reach out and start. *"It's very easy. I can join class at home or I can come here"*. We can't wait to see Sandra continue to improve and feel more confident in her English.




